What to Expect at AMSFest?

- ❖ It is a packed few days so be prepared for a lot of information coming at you.
- ❖ The pre-sessions offer great advice for tackling these projects. Take advantage of them.
- ❖ Don't be afraid to grab people between sessions – vendors and consultants have down time and are happy to talk with you.
- ❖ Tap your cohort leaders for free advice – them all been down this road a few (hundred) times!

- ❖ There are a wide range of solutions available at AMSFest
- ❖ Knowing where you fit in the mix will save yourself and the vendors time and energy.
- ❖ A few key things to have at the ready:
 - ❖ Annual budget
 - ❖ Staff Size
 - ❖ Member Size
 - ❖ Type – Professional, Trade, Hybrid
 - ❖ Search Timeframe



What Are Your Pillars for Success?

- ❖ Knowing where your association is most active will help drive the key things to focus on – usually 8 to 12 key items.
- ❖ Sample:
 - ❖ Finance
 - ❖ Member Self Service
 - ❖ Membership
 - ❖ Small Events & Webinars
 - ❖ Committees
 - ❖ Journal/Magazine Subscriptions
 - ❖ Tracking CPE Awards
 - ❖ Email Newsletters
 - ❖ Grassroots Advocacy

Who to Bring With You?

- ❖ Getting a wider audience to review solutions can give you valuable perspective.
- ❖ It can be a great way to get your team engaged in the project.



How to Get the Most Out of Demos

- ❖ There is a great line-up of different solutions.
- ❖ Vendors are happy to field questions but be respectful and do not get down in the weeds with problems you are currently having.
- ❖ Be sure to do a little homework before you go and target solutions that are good fits based on size/budget/functionality.

- ❖ Demos are hard to keep straight!



**Other* Organization Types included honor societies and certification entities.


Number of Employees at Association Staff Organizations

Actual projects take longer than expected


Number of Months b/t deciding system was needed and selecting new system

- 19% took longer than a year


Expected number of months for system selection

Actual projects take longer than expected


Number of Months b/t system selection and system implementation

Implementation
